### **BEDFORD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MAKE ARRESTS FOR LARCENY**

Bedford, Virginia – On March 20, 2011 a Deputy Sheriff with the Bedford County Sheriff's Office came in contact with Jeffery Todd Lynch and Wendy Lynch at a Southside Electric Cooperative substation in Moneta, VA. When the Deputy approached the subjects he observed narcotics in the subjects vehicle in plain view. Upon subsequent search of one of the subjects, the Deputy discovered a lock that had been cut off the gate of the SEC substation. Furthermore, a transformer, valued at approximately \$2000.00, was located in the subject's vehicle. The Deputy contacted Southside Electric Cooperative who advised they were actually missing several transformers. The Deputy then requested that Deputies with the Franklin County Sheriff's Office go by the subject's residence in Franklin County to attempt to locate the other missing transformers. While on scene, Franklin County Deputies did not locate the other missing transformers, but did locate a stolen ATV from Bedford County. Both subjects were arrested for Grand Larceny and transported to the Blue Ridge Regional Jail in Bedford.
