HOME INVASION SUSPECTS CAPTURED

Bedford County, VA – Sheriff Brown reports that a desperate call for help was received from a woman on April 23rd, at 1:02 AM who advised that several individuals had broken into her home and were assaulting her husband.

Bedford County deputies arrived at the home in the Body Camp area of the county and were met by the husband of the caller who told officers that three men broke through his front door and beat him using their fists and feet. There was reportedly a fourth person who stayed on the front steps and served as a look-out.

Pertinent information gathered by Deputies while interviewing the complainants and witnesses, led to the development of several suspects which launched the investigation.

The following individuals were arrested in Bedford County, on April 25, 2011, without incident, and are charged with **VA Code 18.2-91 Entering a dwelling, house, etc, with intent to commit larceny, assault and battery or other felony**. If convicted each could receive a prison term of 1 to 20 years and up to \$2,500 fine.
